


StashAway™ Car Recyling Bins Instructions HR-5614

Components:

- 1 Open top trash bin (A)
- 1 StuffTop top trash bin (B)
- 4 Stability braces (C)







The StashAway Car Recyling Bins can be used in many ways - individually on seat backs, individually on the floor, together on the floor, and together on the seat back depending on your desired use and vehicle.

Installing the Stability Braces:

- 1) Start with an open bin and 2 stability braces
- 2) Expand the bin to make a box shape
- 3) Take one of the stability braces and snap into place (figure 1)
- 4) Repeat on the other side of the bin
- 5) Repeat with StuffTop bin



To Join Recycling Bins together

- 1) Locate snaps on the outside of each bin (figure 2)
- 2) Place the 2 bins next to each other
- 3) Press snaps together
- 4) Flip StuffTop cover into the closed position

To use joined recycling bins on the floor


- 1) Tuck straps inside mesh pockets on back of bins
- 2) Place on floor (hook and loop fasteners help secure to carpets)



Snaps - 2 top and 2 bottom on each bin

Using Recycling Bins together on back of seat

1) With all straps unbuckled, locate the two inner straps (a & b) on the bins and tuck into mesh pockets (c & d) on the back of the bins. You will not need these straps for installation 2) Take the 2 remaining outside straps (e & f), one the each bin. (Figure 3) wrap longest strap (f) around headrest post(s) and snap into the buckle strap (e) on the other bin - adjust strap accordingly



Using Recycling Bins Separately on floor

- 1) Place on car floor that allows you the easiest access
- 2) Place hand inside bin and press the bottom of the bin down to secure the hook and loop fasteners to the carpet

Using Recycling Bins Separately on seatback

- 1) Place one of the bins on the back of the seat
- 2) Take the longest strap on the back of the bin, wrap it around the headrest post and buckle to secure.
- 3) Repeat with other bin on the other seat back

To clean:

1) Wipe with a damp cloth
